

QUAKER HAVEN CAMP 2021 COVID GUIDELINES

- **BEFORE COMING TO CAMP:**
 - Any students who have had a fever, sore throat, noticeable change in taste or smell, or other identified COVID symptoms are asked to stay home
 - All campers and counselors will have their temperature taken and recorded as they enter the camp
 - *Anyone displaying a temperature of 100 or higher will be refunded their registration and asked to leave*
- **DURING CAMP:**
 - Face Masks
 - When indoors, face masks are required
 - Hand Sanitizer will be made available and must be used frequently throughout the day
 - Daily Temperature Checks
 - Temperature will be taken and recorded each day for the duration of the camp
 - Campers with temperatures or symptoms will be isolated from other campers until released to parent
 - Cabin Procedures:
 - Once assigned, counselors will not move to a different cabin
 - Once assigned, campers will not move to a different cabin
 - Access will be limited to individuals who reside in that cabin
 - Do not share common items (bedding, cups, etc.)
 - Belongings should be limited to essential items, to allow more space
 - Campers belongings should not be intermixed
 - Bathroom Procedures:
 - No sharing common bathroom supplies (towels, toothpaste, etc.)
 - Bathroom toiletries must be contained in a tote or other container
 - Create staggered bathing schedule and limit number of people using facilities at one time (right before bed or morning)
 - A trash can will be placed near the exit of the restrooms
 - Sleeping procedures:
 - Six feet of space between heads
 - Position sleepers head to toe or toe to toe
 - Use bedding that can be washed and dried in a dryer, keep each camper's bedding separate
 - Dining hall:
 - Screen food services employees and assess their symptoms each day before work
 - Limit the dining space to allow physical distance
 - Wash hands before & after meals
 - Games:
 - Hold activities outside as much as possible
 - Groups will remain small and in cohorts
 - Instruct campers to wash hands or use hand sanitizer
 - All equipment will be disinfected in between uses
 - Activities:
 - Limit shared high-touch equipment and designate equipment to campers, eg. craft room supplies
 - Routinely clean all shared equipment
